Campbell County School District is honored to coordinate one of the largest local scholarship programs in the state, confirming Campbell County's support of our youth. If you have any questions, please stop by the counseling office in your school. Late applications will not be considered. We will continue with the electronic application process that was started last year. **Paper applications will not be accepted.**

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Scholarship applications will all be submitted electronically through google forms. Each scholarship will have its own form to complete. Each form must include all that is outlined below:

THE **GENERAL APPLICATION** and **SPECIAL APPLICATIONS** CAN BE ALL DOWNLOADED ON YOUR SCHOOL'S WEBSITE

1. **Review all the scholarships** - Select the ones you are eligible to apply for. Pay close attention to the eligible schools section; some scholarships are only available to students attending a certain high school. To apply, click on the name of the scholarship and it will open the google form where you will upload the following items.

*****All file uploads must be in PDF format*****

2. **Applications** - Each application must include the general application to be submitted with all the required information. The general application is available on your school's website. Please fill out the form on a computer and save it as all the applications will require this to be uploaded. Please ask someone to proofread your application for grammar, spelling, etc., as it is a negative reflection on you when applications are submitted with errors.

Some scholarships will require a special application in addition to the general application. This could be an additional form to be included or you will be directed to the donors website for application submission.

3. **Self-description to upload with each application** - Written in your own words describe personal characteristics and accomplishments that would help a committee get to know you as a person. This essay can be written in first person. Include personal and academic goals, interests and hobbies, contributions to the school and community, and any significant events and experiences that have influenced your life. Be sure to include what field of study you are going into. This statement should not be more than two pages long and should be double-spaced.

4. **Three (3) letters of recommendation** - Must be uploaded with all applications. These can be from teachers, employers, coaches or mentors. Letters should not be written by family members. Ask for an electronic copy for upload.

5. **Transcript** - Each application must include a copy of your transcript which **MUST** include 7 high school semesters and current class rank. These will be available in your counseling office sometime in January.

6. **Additional Items** - Essays, financial information, art portfolios, videos, etc. specifically requested by scholarship donors. Pay close attention to these details listed under 'requirements' for each scholarship. This information will be uploaded under "Additional Items".

You must complete and submit all applications through your school email or it will not accept the application!

1. General Application (available on your school website) and Special Application if applicable to the scholarship.
2. Self-Description (1-2 pages)
3. 3 Letters of Recommendation
4. Transcript (7 semesters)
5. Additional essays, financial information, portfolios, videos, etc. specifically requested by scholarship donors
6. You will receive a response once your application has been submitted successfully. Only submit one (1) application per scholarship.
7. Completed applications must be submitted by **THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 13, 2025 at 4:00 pm. NO EXCEPTIONS! All applications submitted after 4PM will be deleted.**

*****Once an application has been submitted, reopening and/or making corrections is not possible*****

ADDITIONAL NOTES:

1. Completed application must be submitted by **THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 13, 2025 at 4:00 pm**, with the exception of a few scholarships that have their own deadline. Some of the Special Application scholarships also require that you turn them in directly to the company or organization offering the scholarship, so pay close attention to special dates and other instructions.

APPLICATIONS SUBMITTED AFTER THE DEADLINE OF THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 13, 2025 @ 4:00 PM WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. **ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS!!** All applications will be date & time stamped upon successful submission. **Any applications received after 4PM on February 13, 2025 will be deleted.**

2. If you are chosen to receive a scholarship, you will be mailed an invitation prior to Scholarship Night. **IF YOU DO NOT RECEIVE AN INVITATION, YOU ARE NOT THE RECIPIENT OF A SCHOLARSHIP!** Please stop by your schools Counseling Office if you are questioning whether or not you are invited.
3. If you are a scholarship recipient, you will be given instructions on how to accept it with your certificate on Scholarship Night. It is very important that you follow these instructions to ensure you receive your scholarship money.
4. In nearly all cases, the scholarship must be used during the immediate fall semester after graduation.
5. **ALL APPLICANTS MUST GRADUATE BY MAY 2025, MUST BE A FULL TIME STUDENT IN THE CAMPBELL COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT - NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Directions for Using the Chrome Extension:

PDF Combiner: Merge PDF Files

1. **Make sure all letters are saved as a PDF.**
2. **Download PDFs to your computer desktop.**
3. **Install the Extension**
 - Open Google Chrome.
 - [Go to the Chrome Web Store.](#)
 - Search for [PDF Combiner: Merge PDF Files.](#)
 - Click Add to Chrome and then select Add Extension to install it.
4. **2. Open the Extension**
 - After installation, you will see the PDF Combiner icon in the top-right corner of your Chrome window (next to the address bar).
 - Click on the PDF Combiner icon to launch the extension.
5. **Upload PDF Files**
 - Click on the Choose Files button.
 - Select the PDF files you want to merge from your computer. You can select multiple files by holding down the Ctrl (Windows) or Cmd (Mac) key while clicking on the files.
 - Once selected, the files will appear in the list within the extension.
6. **Arrange Files**
 - If necessary, you can reorder the PDFs by clicking and dragging the files into the desired order.
 - This order will determine how they are merged.
7. **Merge the PDFs**
 - After arranging the files, click the Merge PDFs button.
 - The extension will process your files and combine them into a single PDF.
8. **Download the Merged PDF**
 - Once the merge is complete, a download button will appear.
 - Click Download to save the merged PDF file to your computer.
9. **Check Your File**
 - Open the downloaded PDF to ensure that all pages have been correctly combined in the order you wanted.



Tips:

- Make sure the files you are merging are in PDF format.
- If the files are large, it may take a little longer to merge them.
- If you need to add more files, click the Choose Files button again before merging.

That's it! You have successfully merged your PDF files using the PDF Combiner extension.
