4. Three letters of recommendation. Letters could be from a teacher, a member of your church of community, an employer (past or present).
5. An official grade transcript.
6. Applicant must be a Wyoming resident.

- A person who has graduated or will be graduating from an accredited Wyoming High School or have completed the past year at a qualified University or school of higher education.
- A person who is seriously motivated to attend and graduate from an institution of higher learning.
- A resident of the State of Wyoming.
- A person who has achieved a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher.
- Relatives of an active WAA member in good standing that has or will be graduating from an accredited High School or have completed the past year at a qualified University or school of higher education may be given preferential consideration.
