

Campbell County Farm Bureau Scholarship Guidelines

One or More \$2,500 scholarships

This application must be submitted no later than March 1 to the Farm Bureau Office at:

Qualifications:

1. Applicant or applicant's family must be a current regular or associate member of the Campbell County Farm Bureau Federation.
2. Applicant must either have a High School Diploma, GED or be in the current graduating class.
3. Applicant must have at least a 3.0 scholastic grade point average based upon a 4.0 scale.
4. Applicant must be enrolled at a Wyoming Junior College, the University of Wyoming, or at a Wyoming technical school at the time the scholarship funds are actually granted.
5. The application form must be accompanied by all required attachments.
6. No one will be disqualified because of sex, race, color, creed or religious beliefs.

The following attachments are required

1. A recent photograph.
2. A brief History of yourself so that we may know you better as a person. Please give us the names of both your parents, as well as the number of years you or your parents have been with the Farm Bureau as well as any involvement your family has had in the Farm Bureau. Please list the elementary, junior, and high schools attended as well as the college or university you plan to attend. What course of study are you pursuing? What school activities or organizations have you participated in as well as any extracurricular activities such as church, community, 4 H, family Business participation, jobs, etc? Give us a brief description of your financial status and your need for financial assistance. Please be complete in this letter of introduction to us, as this is a large part of the decision process.
3. An Official transcript of your most recent year's grades.
4. Letters of recommendation which preferably would include a farm bureau board of director member or a regular or associate member. Also school teachers or school administrators indicating your ability, character and interests as well as a letter from your current employer if applicable. Please include several of these letters if possible.
5. Please include your address, as well as a phone number, if you have one.

Scholarships will be selected by a point system utilizing the above attachments

- 20 pts Scholastic record
- 15 pts School organizations and activities
- 15 pts other organizations
- 15 pts financial need
- 10 pts References
- 5 pts CCFB Federation Family's involvement
- 20 pts your written introduction to the scholarship committee
